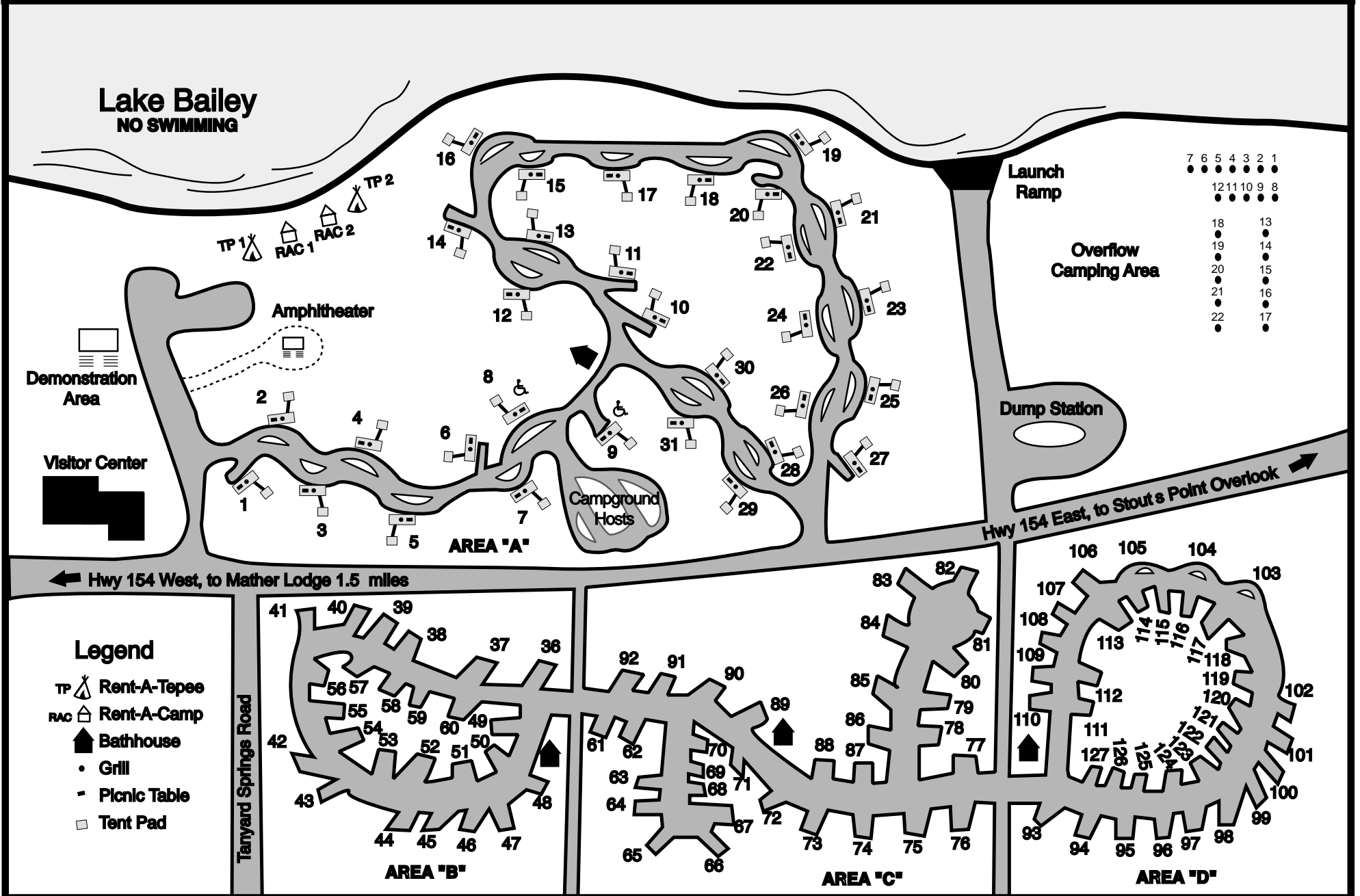


# Petit Jean State Park Campground Map



## Dear Guest,

Welcome to Petit Jean State Park! My staff and I are very excited to have you here as our guest and would like to make your visit as enjoyable and safe as possible. During your stay, if you have any questions, comments, or concerns please share them with a member of the park staff.

For your safety and to protect park facilities and resources, I would like to mention some of our rules and state laws that must be adhered to during your stay at Petit Jean State Park.

- Camping check-in time is anytime after 3:00 pm on the date of arrival. Check-out time is 3:00 pm on your departure date.
- Camping sites may have up to two (2) camping units (one (1) trailer/RV and one (1) tent, or two (2) tents). If you have additional camping units or tents you will have to rent another site.
- Up to eight (8) people may occupy a camping site.
- Please be courteous to other guests and observe quiet hours, which are 10:00 pm to sunrise. Our campsites are fairly close to one another and it doesn't take much for neighboring campers to be disturbed by loud talking or music.
- Petit Jean State Park closes to the visiting public at 10:00 pm. All persons not registered must vacate by that time or will be asked to leave.
- All terrain vehicles (ATV), golf carts, motorized bicycles, scooters and mini bikes may not be operated within the park unless they are licensed by the State of Arkansas and insured when legally operated they are limited to public roads.
- Per state laws 27-34-104 and 27-35-104, it is unlawful for anyone under the age of 15 to ride in the bed of a pickup truck.
- The sale of goods, merchandise, or services is not permitted without a permit issued by Arkansas State Parks. This includes "FOR SALE" signs on vehicles or other items while in the park.
- Pets are allowed anywhere in the park, but not in park facilities, as long as they are on a leash and under direct physical control of the owner.
- Disorderly conduct, indecent attire, and abusive language are not allowed.
- The destruction, defacing or removal of any public property is unlawful including the injury or defacing of trees, removal of plants, or destruction of signs, buildings, or equipment.

These rules are enforced to make your stay here at Petit Jean State Park as enjoyable and safe as possible, and to protect the park for future generations. We greatly appreciate your cooperation on these matters, please enjoy your stay.
